


The Clock Tower Renovation



We are delighted and grateful that so many people have made donations - over 40 individuals or families to date. We have just been awarded a grant of £1,000 from a small charity which sponsors clock repairs, and with the other promised grants and all the kind donations we are now within £4,500 of our total. It's not too late to be involved with the renovation work: there are pamphlets with details in the church and links to the information on www.asbchurch.org A few numbers on the clock

face remain available for sponsorship as we make our last drive for funds.

On current estimates the work should be carried out late summer/early autumn, and we hope to be giving thanks for all that has been achieved through our corporate efforts at our All Saints' Day celebration at the beginning of November when we will dedicate the completed project in thanksgiving for the reign of the late Queen Elizabeth II and to mark the coronation of King Charles III. Everyone will be invited!







As a benefice I would like to draw your attention to a project being run by Hampshire Police.

It's a knitting / crochet initiative to produce bears - 'Bobby Buddies' - for them to use in their work with incidents of domestic abuse.

Previously, police were inundated with offers of help from members of the community to knit the police officer teddy bears. They've been so popular that they're now running low.

The bears, which are knitted by volunteers, are given to children by officers to help communicate with them and break down barriers that can exist when police attend after a domestic incident.

Detective Sergeant Adam Merrick, said: "We were so lucky to have had so many people help us previously and the bears were really well received. These little bears really do help to provide comfort and reassurance to young children when we attend an incident they have been involved in or have witnessed, and can help break down that initial barrier.

"Not only do they reassure the child, making it easier for us to talk to them and find out what has happened, they also help to distract the child if we are trying to talk to their parent.

"The children who receive these bears would have been through a lot and would be recognised as a victim of domestic abuse in their own right under the new Domestic Abuse Act. Being able to greet them with this small gesture really does make a difference and helps put a smile on their face at a difficult time in their lives."

If you would like to knit/crochet a bear - or bears! - please contact Katie Walton — Safeguarding Officer All Saints Awbridge and I can deliver patterns. When the bears are ready for collection drop me a line and I can collect. I will deliver to Southampton Police Station when we have a donation.
