

### From the Rector: Rev Tom Benson

Dear friends,

We are at the beginning of a brand new year with all the challenges and joys that that will inevitably bring with it. I am sure that I am not alone in sometimes feeling that we seem to have more challenges than joys to look forward to over the coming months. However, it is also true, I think, that there is still much to be grateful for. We are fortunate to live in a great part of the country, places that still have such a strong sense of community and where by and large we can live our lives in safety. When there seems to be so much chaos in terms of finance, politics and conflict etc it can skew our view of the world, it can seem a very dark and cruel place, and although there are cruelties and there is darkness those things do not dominate on a day to day basis. The truth is that the world still turns on kindness, those small acts of love that get us through and that we can give and receive every day. It is very often these kindnesses that help to hold us until better times come around. Giving and receiving kindness helps to maintain our hope.

At the start of 2024 we find ourselves once again in a world in which open conflict has broken out in so many regions. The Middle East, Africa and Ukraine are in our news feeds daily. Across our churches we hold everyone affected by these events in our prayers in every service, and I would encourage everyone to keep praying for them (in whatever form that may take) as we go about our daily lives. On the 7<sup>th</sup> of February at 7.30pm we will be holding a service of prayer and lament at All Saints Braishfield where we can join together in witness to the pain and loss that happens when neighbour turns against neighbour. You are all invited to come along; whether you have a faith or not, you are most welcome.

February sees the start of Lent with Ash Wednesday on the 14th. Christians use the six weeks before Easter to prepare themselves for Holy Week and the great joy of Easter Sunday itself - the most important in the Christian calendar when we celebrate that Jesus rose again. It is in the life, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus that we can see what kindness, love and hope look like.

# Reflections and Thoughts of a Ukrainian Family after a Year in Hampshire

Never mind a pin, you couldn't hear a piece of thread drop when Vlad came to the end of his extremely powerful talk at Michelmersh Barns at the end of November.

Vlad is a 22 year old Ukrainian who has lived in Michelmersh with his girlfriend, Katya and their host, Sue for the last 18 months. He was speaking at the monthly Friends of Michelmersh Church talk about his reflections on his flight from Kyiv in February 2022.

It was delivered with confidence and fluency and punctuated with short videos and slide shows. Together they told graphically of his and his family's life and houses before the

Russian invasion and the carnage that remains after they have been bombed and looted. Vlad also shared his vision of his future, which he hopes will be in the UK.

The 40 strong audience was literally stunned to silence whilst we dwelt internally on the personal horror Vlad, Katya and their family have endured, and continue to endure. As Vlad pointed out, theirs is just one story of many.

We are unanimous in our heartfelt thanks to Vlad and Katya for putting together such an inspirational evening; we all returned home with our heads full of sadness and admiration.

The Museum of the Moon artwork by artist Luke Jerram is coming to Winchester for the first time in February 2024.

It was dubbed as one of the National History Museum's most popular exhibits of all time, after 2 million+ visitors congregated there to appreciate its beauty. # Visit the moon from 5<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> February during Cathedral opening hours

'Measuring seven metres in diameter, the moon features 120dpi detailed NASA imagery of the lunar surface. At an approximate scale of 1:500,000, each centimetre of the internally lit spherical sculpture represents 5km of the moon's surface. Wander the majestic nave of Winchester Cathedral by moonlight and feel amazed by this breathtaking installation.'

Choose the session which suits you best. Vary from week to week if you need to.


